DIRECTIONS: VAIL LAKE RESORT.COM

From San Diego: Take Interstate 5 N to Interstate 8 E and take Interstate 15 N for about 40 miles. Take the Highway 79 S Temecula Pkwy. Make a right, and head East for 9 miles. Our entrance is on the left.

From Los Angeles: Take Interstate 10, 60, or 91 East to the Interstate 15 S. Drive South until you get to Temecula. The last exit before leaving Temecula is Highway 79 S TEMECULA PKWY towards INDIO. Take this exit to the left, and head East for 9 miles. You will find us on the left.

THE COURSE: The 2.5 KM length course consists of mostly grass and dirt roads while taking advantage of the natural elevation surrounding the venue. There will be one stairs section and one barrier section.

THE VENUE. The Butterfield Country Recreational Park (now Vail Lake Resort) was established in 1968 to provide public access to the lake and its marina, but closed by its owners in 1989. In 1995, a members-only resort facility was opened at the location of the former park; and in 2000, the water activities area was re-opened to the public on an annual fee basis. Today, boating rights on the lake are reserved for annual members only but RV access is open to the public with paid nightly reservation or a day use pass. www.vaillakeresort.com

REGISTRATION: Online registration available. Series discount pass available. Go to www.socalcross.org/register for details. **Online registration closes Thursday October 6th at 11:59PM (Pacific).** Race Day registration opens 2 hours prior to race category start and closes 20 minutes prior to race category start.

ENTRY FEES: *\$5.00 Second race pricing applies after HIGHER entry fee is paid.

RULES: Event held under American Bicycle Racing Permit. All 2011 ABR rules apply. Event will be held rain or shine, no refunds. Cyclocross and hard tail Mountain Bikes (no bar ends) recommended. Bicycle and wheel changes are allowed in the designated pit areas only. No feeds are allowed on course except under discretion of the race officials. Riders must wear helmets when on the bike at all times. Riders shall stay on the course or existing trails. Please respect the venue.



USA Cycling does not recognize ABR for upgrade or national ranking points.

Warming up on the Course Once the last rider has crossed the line in the current active wave, the officials will allow riders to **"pre-ride"** the course so they can become familiar with route. Please enter the course just past the finish line and do not pass or enter in front of riders who are still racing on the course. As in the past, while pre-riding do not cross the finish line while the timing system is running and do not pass active racers on course. There will always be enough time to complete one lap before the next race starts. Once the next race has started, warming up on the course is not allowed.

CATEGORIES: Senior (over 18 years of age in 2012) and Masters categories may be listed by ability as well as age. Ability categories are as follows. The Prestige Series discourages sandbagging. Please upgrade when eligible.

A	USAC Road/CX Cat 1 and 2, MTB Cat 1/Expert and anyone else who chooses to race at this level.
B	USAC Road/CX Cat 3 and 4, MTB Cat 2/Sport and anyone who chooses to race at this level.
C	USAC Road 4 and 5, CX 4, MTB Cat 3/Beginner. New racers or those trying cyclocross for the first time.

CYCLOCROSS RACING AGE: A rider's racing age for the 2011-12 Cyclocross Season is the 'racing age' they'll be the year of the CX World Championships which take place in January 28-29, 2012 **Your racing age for the entire cyclocross season running September 2011 through January 2012 is your age as of 12/31/2012.**
